
RECALL NOTICE

Ravin Crossbows Reannounces Recall of White Arrow Nocks Due to Injury Hazard and Additional Incidents; Offers Incentive for Returned White Nocks





Hazard: If the nock is not fully clipped to the bowstring, the Ravin® Crossbow may not discharge when the trigger is pulled. Failure to return the Safety to the SAFE position may result in the bow discharging while re-nocking of the arrow.

Recalled Product: This recall involves all white plastic molded clip-on nocks used in arrows for Ravin brand crossbows. The white arrow nocks were sold in a package of 12 and also as original equipment with Ravin R9 and R15 crossbows and with Ravin arrows. The white nocks measure about .9 inches long.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled white arrow nocks and contact Ravin Crossbows for free replacement orange nocks and a merchandise credit for another Ravin product of up to \$1.00 for each white nock. Follow the manufacturer's instructions and maintenance guidelines at https://ravincrossbows.com/ for continued safe operation of the crossbows and nocks.
